

South Carolina Ordinance of Secession Signers Monument
South Carolina Division, Sons of Confederate Veterans

The Signers Monument, erected and dedicated in November 2018, memorializes the delegates to the South Carolina Secession Convention held in Charleston in December 1860. The monument is a lasting tribute to some of the finest men our state has ever produced and tells the true story of arguably the most important event in South Carolina's history, engraved in massive granite for future generations to come. The Signers Monument is located on historical Secession Hill in Abbeville, SC. The Secession Hill property is owned by the Secession Hill Memorial Trust.

Just as the SC Division, SCV used granite pavers, park benches, coins, and palmetto trees to raise funds for the construction of the monument, pavers, benches, and palmetto trees are still available for anyone to memorialize an ancestor, family, SCV Camp, Confederate hero, etc. Your inscription will be engraved in the granite paver, bench, or marker placed at the base of a palmetto tree on the corner of the monument's heritage plaza.

Donation options are as follows:

1. 4 inch X 8-inch granite paver. 3 lines of inscription, 17 characters, and spaces per line. \$100.00
2. 8 inch X 8-inch granite paver. Located around the monument's base, limited availability. 5 lines of inscription, 17 characters and spaces per line. \$1000.00
3. Corner of plaza palmetto tree, granite marker at the base of the tree. 5 lines of inscription, 24 characters, and spaces per line. There are 2 trees available as of 7/15/2021. Please call for availability. \$2500.00
4. Granite park bench. Multiple options on inscriptions. 2 benches are available as of 7/15/2021. A bench is a great option for a family or group to donate. Please call for availability. \$5000.00
